

How to get to South Tyrol

Whether you want to book a package with a tour operator or book independently, South Tyrol is easy to reach from the UK.

Tour operators featuring South Tyrol include Inghams, Thomson, Crystal, Inntravel, Kuoni, Equity Ski, Esprit Ski, Momentum Ski, Neilson, Mountain Tracks, Exodus Travel, Powder Byrne, FreeWheel holidays and Expressions Holidays.

It is also easy to put together your own holiday to South Tyrol as many low cost airlines fly into nearby airports:

Flights to Verona from the UK (1.5 hours' drive from Bolzano/Bozen):

- **Ryanair** from London Stansted
- **BA** from London Gatwick

Flights to Venice from the UK (approximately 2.5 hours' drive from Bolzano)

- **bmi** from London Heathrow and Manchester
- **BA** from Gatwick and Manchester
- **Ryanair** from Stansted, Liverpool, Shannon and Dublin
- **easyJet** from Stansted, East Midlands, Gatwick, Bristol and Belfast

Flights to Milan from the UK (approximately 3 hours' drive from Bolzano):

- **Ryanair** from Stansted, London Luton, East Midlands, Bristol, Bournemouth, Manchester, Liverpool, Glasgow, Shannon and Dublin
- **easyJet** from Gatwick, Bristol and Edinburgh

Flights to Innsbruck from the UK (approximately 80 minutes' drive from Bolzano):

- **easyJet** from London Gatwick, Liverpool, Manchester and Bristol

Car hire is available from all airports and hotels can arrange airport transfers for guests. Passengers flying in to Milan Bergamo, Verona Catullo, Venice Marco Polo or Venice Treviso can now also connect with low cost transfers to all the major resorts in South Tyrol from as little as €29 return. The transfers can now be booked online via lowcostcoach.com. For more information visit suedtirool.info/transfer. For a direct flight to Bolzano in South Tyrol Alitalia flies to Rome where Air Alps offers connecting flights to Bolzano.
